We are confident that the exhibition will inspire all of us to reflect and act towards a more sustainable future.

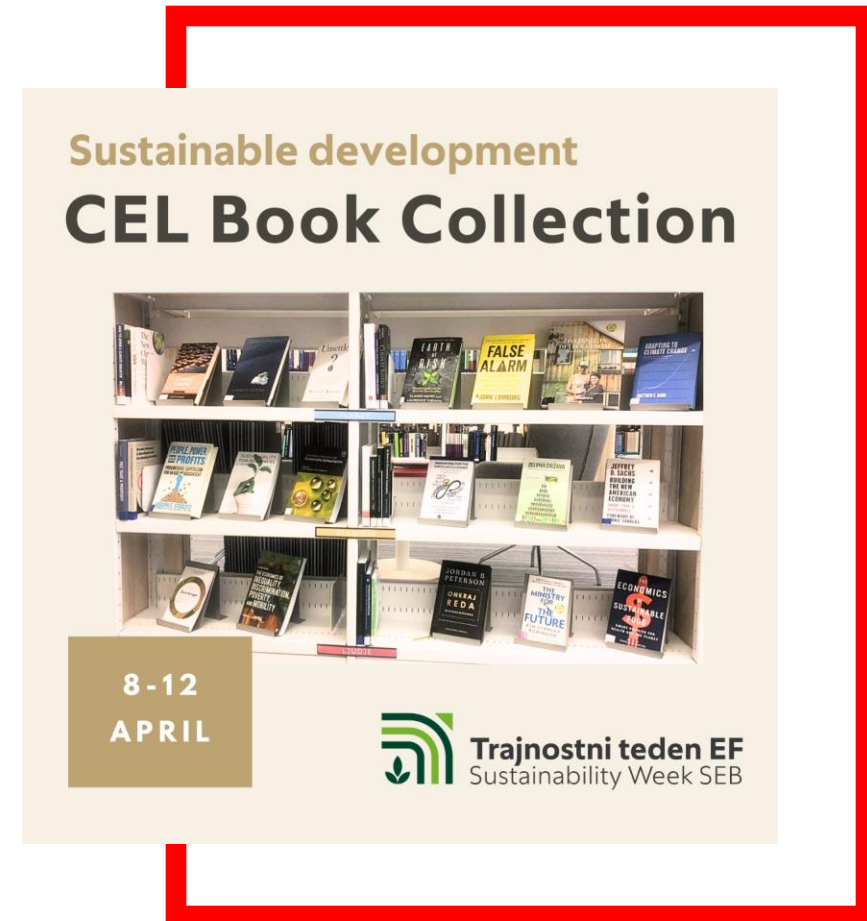
